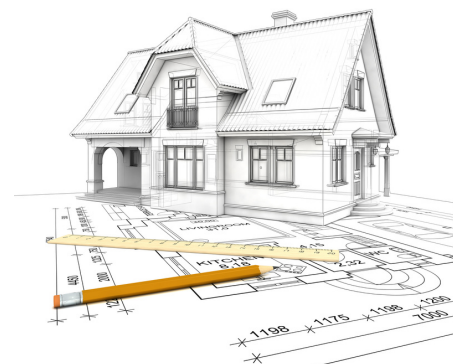


Blueprint Reading & Material Take-Off

- Students will be introduced to various residential construction methods and estimating formulas while working on a basic single level home with a trussed roof.
